The Beach Caravan Park – Accessibility Statement

- The Beach Caravan Park is sited on 2 levels. The park is large and spacious and is accessed through 2 bridges, with a height of 10ft 9 and width of 5 meters.
- The distance to the beach from the main reception area is 56 meters; also foot/cycle path that runs from Prestatyn to Rhos on Sea and is 2 meters wide.
- There is parking in front of reception, The Beachcomber and Tides café/bistro on a gravelled car park; 81 meters long by 29 meters wide. 3 entrances to car park, the largest being 9 meters wide.
- Entrance to the park is through a secure barrier, which is 3.7 meters wide. 2 exit points, 1 being 3.7 meters wide the other being 3.3 meters wide.
- Main reception on park with 2 entrance doors, 1st being 790 mm wide, 2nd being 790 mm wide. Entrance to Tides café/bistro is 1050mm wide and the Beachcomber Bar entrance being 790 mm wide. There is also a Launderette on site and the entrance door is 760 mm wide.
- Distance from Tides to Reception is 14 meters, and distance from Reception Entrance to Beachcomber Entrance is 12 meters.
- There is a bus service at the main road entrance www.arriva.co.uk Trains www.nationalrail.co.uk
- The Beach Caravan Park has privately owned static caravans and a small hire fleet.
- All caravans are sited on concrete bases with parking available outside caravans. Parking on the grass is not permitted.
- Tarmac roads service all parts of the park and speed ramps are placed at regular intervals. Speed limit is 5 mph.
- Access to The Beachcomber is through a 790 mm wide side door with ramp for wheelchairs. Main door is 1040 mm wide although there is an external step to the entrance of 160 mm high. There are 3 internal doors, which are 800 mm wide. There is an adult's pool table in the sports bar and also 1 in the children's arcade along with a variety of gaming machines and change machines. There is a family room where your children can stay with you throughout the day/evening. There is a T.V in the Children's area, the family room and the sports bar.
- There is seating and tables outside The Beachcomber with a canopy.
- There are female and male toilets in the main bar area and female and male in the children's room. There is also a disabled toilet with baby changing facilities. There are toilets within Tides café/bistro, including unisex and disabled with baby changing facilities.
